BROMAC JONES BUILDING A PICKET FENCE

Sent out hot favourite in his bid to go three for three on Australian soil, **Bromac Jones** did that in tradesman like fashion at Albion Park yesterday.

Drawn five behind the gate, he was three wide early before settling into the death seat where he stayed until striding clear over the last 200m of the 1660m journey.

Rating 1:57.9 for the distance with an overall time of 2:01.6, the last half was in 58.3 with a final quarter of 29.7 – covered in a manner that he simply did enough to win.

His three Australian starts have seen mile rates of 1:58.5, 1:56.5 and 1:57.9 respectively.
