

TORRID BROMAC REPEATS AT HARRINGTON

Former useful NZ pacer Torrid Bromac, a five-year-old Courage Under Fire entire from Tanisa Bromac (Live Or Die-Tanisa Vance), notched his third win in five USA starts with a repeat win at Harrington Raceway, Delaware, on Tuesday (NZ time).

In the process, the Bromac Lodge-bred pacer shaved 0.2 of a second off his winning time for his first two mile wins in North America, this time pacing 1:55 even.

He settled handy from the four gate, led in the open at the three-quarters, and went on to score by 2 1/4 lengths.

Torrid Bromac, exported to North America in late July, has quickly accumulated over \$US18,000 in earnings since joining the Chris Marino stable.

A winner of eight and 11 times placed in 38 NZ starts for \$64,663, Torrid Bromac is one of five

individual winners for the consistent-producing Bromac Lodge mare Tanisa Bromac (TT, 1:58.4).

The Live Or Die dam has also left Tijuana Bromac (1:57.5, 15 wins & \$124,897), (Black) Mr Mach (1:56.5, nine wins & \$84,109), minor winners, Twitter Bromac and Trinity Bromac and Verdelho, a Mach Three filly qualifier at two for trainer Brent Mangos at Pukekohe in June in a 2:03.8 rate (2050m).

In recent seasons, Tanisa Bromac, a half-sister to big international winner of \$400,000 in Ross The Boss (1:50, US, 10 NZ wins, 24 USA wins), Tallyho Bromac (1:53.7 mile rate, Aust, 22 wins & \$131,031), Kotare Jaeger (p2, 1:56.8, 10 wins \$72,343) and Habeebee (formerly Toffee Bromac, 1:54.8, US, six wins), has left another Mach Three filly in Sheza Bromac (now two) and a yearling filly by champion sire Bettor's Delight.

She was bred last December with the fast USA pacer Roll With Joe, a 1:48.4 winning son of Cam's Card Shark.
