BROMACS TAKE CLASSY DOUBLE AT MT GAMBIER

Put Your Lights On was backed as unbeatable in the St Ledger at Mt Gambier last night and showed why with a 29 metre cruising victory.

The three year old son of **Badlands Hanover** and **Ursula Bromac** made it 8 wins from just 12 Australian starts – all this season.

Off the track since January 21st when he took out the Mt Gambier Derby by an ever increasing 18.40 metres, this time he showed blistering speed from the widest alley on the front row to hit the lead early and from there the Derby/St Leger double was never in doubt.

The 2190m was covered in 2:48.5 with the field following him home at intervals.

A couple of races earlier **Guapo Bromac** made it from inside alley on the second row to sit outside the favourite and race leader **Special Cellar** for the majority of the race before pulling clear in the home straight.

Guapo Bromac is a four year old son of **Holmes Hanover** and **Gilt Laughter** and was recording his second Australian win from just 8 starts to date.
