USHAKA BROMAC RUNS THEM OFF THEIR FEET

Continentalman mare **Ushaka Bromac** showed just how good she is when she stayed level after running her opposition of their feet at Menangle tonight.

Drawn the outside of the front line she blitzed the start and was soon in the lead with clear air between her and the trailing horse , a gap back to the third runner and the rest well behind.

Over the 2300m such was her clip that it was not until the 500m mark that the rest even got level with the sulky of the third runner.

On the home turn trailing horse **Earldom** pulled out to issue a challenge, but the leader simply lifted a gear and dropped him in her wake.

Never looking like being challenged, let alone beaten, **Ushaka Bromac** won by an untouched 7 metres with **Twotter Peck** finishing stoutly late to take second off **Earldom** with the rest in a gap.

Ushaka Bromac trotted the 2300m stand in 2:57.7 with her last quarter in 28.9.

It was her second win from 6 starts this campaign along with 2 seconds and a good fourth in the trotters championship final series at Menangle on May 28th.
