J'ADORE AND JUNIPER OUTCLASS THEIR RIVALS

Two Bromac fillies with highly promising futures made winning look easy when they both took out their second race day appearances yesterday.

Juniper Bromac was first up, drawing 10 over the mile at Winton but making light of her alley.

Zippering round to the lead going down the back straight she made it look easy, romping to a 3 ¾ length win – untouched – and with the field well spread out behind her.

Even more impressive was the three year old filly's time for the mile – 1:55.8 with the last half in an easy 57.4.

Juniper Bromac is the fourth foal of her dam and amazingly enough – the FOURTH 2:00 winner... a 100% strike rate ... and they have ALL been fillies.

Her dam is the **Falcon Seelster** mare **Jasmine Bromac** and her sire **Live Or Die** - also the sire of 2003 foal **Jazz Bromac** p, 1:58.9 and 2005 foal **Jade Bromac** p, 1:56.8 to date. **Mystical Shark** was the sire of the 2004 filly **Jonty Bromac** p, 1:56.7 in Australia to date.

Jasmine Bromac's two foals following **Juniper Bromac** were both colts but unfortunately both died early. Her only other foal is a 2010 filly by **Courage Under Fire**.

Moving along a few hours and **J'Adore Bromac** stepped out onto the racing surface of Addington Raceway.

Hot favourite after an impressive debut 2nd, the **McArdle** filly was allowed to settle midfield from her wide draw over the 1950m mobile.

It was obvious a long way from home however that she was the one to beat and so it proved, with driver John Dunn pulling her out to make her run as they straightened and she came home easily to win scoring by an impressive 1 ½ lengths.

J'Adore Bromac is a daughter of the four time **Group 1** placed filly **Jillbo** and a half brother to the promising **Bromac Jones** who went 1:56.5 at three years in Australia last season and raced amongst the elite of his age.

Making **J'Adore Bromac**'s win even more timely is the entry of her **Mach Three** half brother **J R Bromac** in the upcoming Yearling Sales.
