

TIJUANA BROMAC EXTENDS IN AUSSIE



Tijuana Bromac

Tijuana Bromac (8g Falcon Seelster-Tanisa Bromac), last season's North Island Country Cups Final winner, furthered his career by winning his first race across the Tasman on Saturday, May 6.

Still raced by Blenheim co-owners Anne-Marie and Jeremy Best, Tijuana Bromac was notching his first win in 13 Australian starts when successful at Albion Park, Brisbane, in a 1:57.5 rate (2138m).

This was the 14th career win for the \$112,708 lifetime winner.

Tijuana Bromac, now trained and driven by Narissa McMullen, led throughout from his ace draw in the Erin Molan @ Botra Charity Race Day Band 5 Conditioned Pace.

Last season's Hawera Cup winner drew clear by 5.1 metres to beat fellow NZ-bred Raesawinner, quickening over his last 800m in 56.8s.

Tijuana Bromac was the first winner for his dam Tanisa Bromac (TT, 1:58.1).

Her third foal (Black) Mr Mach made his mark in West Australia, having taken a 1:56.3 mark, winning nine races and \$84,109.

She's also left the minor winner Twitter Bromac, and the capable Torrid Bromac (1:56.7), winner in NZ of seven races from 32 starts for \$56,548.

Tanisa Bromac is a half-sister to former smart NZ winner and 1:50 US miler Ross The Boss (10 NZ wins & over \$400,000 lifetime), Habeebee (1:53.6, US), \$A129,000 winner Tallyho Bromac (1:53.7, 22 wins) and Kotare Jaeger (p2, 1:56.9, 10 wins & \$A72,343).

Another half-sister in Tessa Bromac is the dam of smart Australian pacer Tullow (1:52.7), 15 wins from 62 starts for \$133,317.
