LAST OUT FIRST HOME WORKS FOR VIENNA BROMAC

A front line draw of 7 over the mile was not enough to stop **Vienna Bromac** recording her second sub 1:55 victory at Menangle last night.

An opening quarter of 27.3 saw **Vienna Bromac** being given time to find her feet, enough so that with 1200m to go she was last ... and at the 500m mark she was still last, off the rail but stuck inside the last horse on the 3 wide line.

Inside the last quarter she was still last but in the 3 wide line and on the home turn she was still last but 6 wide and in clear air.

And that was all she needed – to the relief of the public who had sent her out hot favourite!

Vienna Bromac wound up the best in the field and grabbed the lead late in the piece to record a 1:54.9 mile , her last quarter significantly faster than the 28.2 recorded off the front.

The ultra- consistent mare was recording her sixth win from 13 starts in Australia – all since landing on the shores in September last year. She has also recorded 2 seconds and two thirds with her worst finish a sixth in February.

She is yet to miss a place at Menangle – her 6 starts on the track snaring 4 wins, a second and a third. Her winning times being 1:57.2; 1:55.5; 1:54 and 1:54.9 respectively.

Vienna Bromac is a daughter of **Courage Under Fire** and **Universal Woman**, the latter from a family strong in both juvenile performers and older toughened campaigners.
