WHEN YOU'RE HOT YOU'RE HOT

You can't ask much more of your kids than they try their best and at the moment, the kids of **Sabrina Bromac** are pretty darn good.

Smudge Bromac only knows how to run first or second this season and won his fifth race from just 10 starts when he won at Cobram last Thursday and big brother **Slick Bromac** refused to be outshone by junior when he proved too big and strong at Harold Park on Saturday night (Aug 6th).

A clear favourite against some pretty smart performers, **Slick Bromac** flew the gate from his wide draw and was always looking sharp.

Turning for home he had three six figure earners (one a half million dollar plus) on his back but they couldn't get close to passing him. **Twelve Paces** got the closest after coming wide on the home turn but he never looked like catching **Slick Bromac**.

The **Falcon Seelster** five-year-old has now 21 races and over \$145,000 lifetime. This season he has been super consistent winning 7 races and notching up another 7 seconds, 3 thirds, a fourth and a fifth from 20 starts. Amongst his victories has been the Listed Shirley Turnbull Memorial while he finished a neck second to **Karlo Mick** (p, 1:54.8 \$1.2 million) in the \$40,000 Young Cup.
