

## ACE BROMAC COULD TARGET 4YO PERTH FEATURES



### **Ace Bromac at Gloucester Park**

Well-performed Ace Bromac (4g Falcon Seelster-Agnes Patron) could step up and be given his chance at Gr. 1 level in the \$200,000 Golden Nugget in Perth on December 8.

Ace Bromac, bred by Bromac Lodge and Trevor Beaton (QSM), was sold unraced out of the Cran Dalgety stable after qualifying in a smart 3:01 at Ashburton in December, 2016.

He's won four of six West Australian starts from the stable of Kyle Harper, who also trains another ex-Kiwi and Grand Circuit pacer Bettor's Fire.

Ace Bromac was first-up since June when he led throughout at short odds to win the C1-4 Steelo's At Gloucester Park Mobile Pace on Tuesday, November 7.

He won as he liked in a 1:58.1 rate over the 2130m, quickening over his last 800m in 57s and his final 400m in 28.3s.

Ace Bromac could build to the Golden Nugget by taking in the Gr. 1 \$125,000 4YO McInerney Ford Classic at Gloucester Park on November 24, and the Gr. 2 \$50,000 4YO Championship at Gloucester Park on December 1.

He has a best winning mile rate in West Australia of 1:56.9, set when winning at Gloucester Park over 2130m in June.

Ace Bromac is a half-brother to last season's Harness Breeders NSW 4YO colt or gelding Pacer of the Year in Aztec Bromac (1:52.3, 14 wins & \$236,620), and other good winners in Angus Bromac (1:54.3, eight wins & \$A69,353) and Avalon Bromac (1:56.1, 10 wins & \$A92,028).

Agnes Patron, since leaving Ace Bromac, has left colts to Art Official (Optimus Prime) and Auckland Reactor (Action Bromac), and a yearling filly by Sunshine Beach, named Anzac Bromac.

She was bred last December with the fast Cam's Card Shark stallion, Roll With Joe (1:48.4), the brother to champion sire Bettor's Delight.

Agnes Patron is a race-placed sister to Albert Patron (1:53, US, 11 NZ wins) and half-sister to Andrew Patron (1:53.8f, US) and Soky's Patron (1:54.8, US).

Grand-dam Anna Patron (1:55, US) won six and was runnerup in a Southland Oaks before winning 29 races and just over \$US100,000 in North America.

Anna Patron (Armbro Raven-Patroness) was a half-sister to the smart filly Shania Patron (p3, 1:56.4 mile rate, 1700m), eight wins & \$176,166 including the 2001 NZ Oaks) and former smart Southland pacer No Return (1:58.1 mile rate, 2000m), nine wins and the runnerup in a NZ Derby.

This is also the family of other good winners in Fifth Edition (1:56.3, 15 wins & \$132,482), 2006 NZ Sapling Stakes winner Jackson Street (1:56.6, 16 wins), Angela's Image (1:57.7, Aust), Brass Lantern (1:56.6, Aust) and Angela's Dream (1:57.2, eight wins & \$118,243, runnerup to Kiwi Ingenuity in the 2008 NZ Oaks and now dam of useful NZ winner Moving Money (1:59.3, two wins).
