CHAY BROMAC STRIKES AGAIN

Falcon Seelster colt **Chay Bromac** backed up recent solid form with a close win in the opening event at Forbury Park last Thursday night (June 10th).

The three year old drew the ace and lead early before taking a trail when stablemate **Deal On The Day** came round and then ending up three back on the rails when **Paris H** made a big run from the back to hit the lead.

Luck came his way at the 600m mark when **Sister Bertrand** who had been in the one out, one back but racing too keenly, started to fade. Driver Adam Sanderson flicked **Chay Bromac** off at that point and then put him 3 wide and challenging as they hit the home bend.

From there it was a matter of who finished the race off best and he got home in the shadows of the post to defeat a game favourite in **Meads Quaff**.

They covered 2200m in 2:47.6 with a mile rate of 2:02.6 and fractions of 59.4 and 29.4.

Chay Bromac took a sub 2:00 record when winning well at Wairio last October.

He may have only won twice from his 17 starts to date but has been a super consistent performer with "top six" finishers in 16 of those starts (7th in the other, his second race start at 2, drawn 7 over a mile).

He is a full brother to NZ's fastest pacer ever **Attorney General** p, 1:48.4 and the smart performer **Captain Bromac** p, 1:59.9 (11 NZ/AU wins to date), and a half brother to this season's very smart Australian juvenile **Cullen Bromac** p2, 1:59.3 (unbeaten in 5 AU starts to date) and **Crown Bromac** p3, 1:57.7 (9 AU wins \$102,951 to date).
