CROWN BROMAC BOLTS IN AT GLOUCESTER PARK

McArdle 4YO **Crown Bromac** bounced back to his best form when he proved too strong for his opposition at Gloucester Park yesterday.

Drawn three but able to start from barrier two after a late scratching of the pole horse, **Crown Bromac** strolled to the lead as the mobile gate pulled away and was never headed thereafter.

The favourite had things pretty much his own way during the first half of the race before taking on a little pressure when **Magiclittlepartner** did a quick three wide move to sit outside him with a lap to go.

However it was as close as the black type mare got, for the leader gradually increased the tempo over the last 1000m - finally getting serious as the final quarter approached.

Come the 400m mark and he was gone leaving his opponents to battle for the minor placings. Untouched he hit the home turn well clear and kept the margin constant, crossing the line almost 6 metres clear of a game **Magiclittlepartner** with a bigger margin back to **Halo Slip**, a fast finishing **Kelvin Bromac** and **Lukcon Lad**, the trio crossing the line close together.

The 2130m mobile journey was covered in a time of 2:42 flat, a mile rate of 2:02.4 and the last quarter in 28 seconds.

Crown Bromac has now won 7 races from just 14 starts with his earnings surpassing the \$50,000 barrier with this latest win. A smart three year old, he won the \$20,000 WA Summer Gift and a heat of the Victoria Derby last season as well as winning two of three starts as a juvenile.

His dam is the American bred mare **Classic Blue Jeans**, a daughter of **Camluck**.

Crown Bromac is a son of successful young sire **McArdle** who in turn is a son of champion sire **Falcon Seelster**, who himself is the sire of **Crown Bromac**'s successful half brothers **Attorney General** p, 1:48.4 \$323,098 (and now a sire in Australia) and **Captain Bromac** p, 1:59.9.

The latter has only been in Australia since late August but has also been keeping the family name to the fore by winning 2 races and recording 3 other placings from seven starts to date. **Attorney General**, one time NZ's fastest pacer ever is just embarking on his own stud career, care of the **Stallion Station**.
