BAILEY BROMAC RECORDS A PAIR OF WINS IN VICTORIA

Bailey Bromac is undefeated in Victoria this month after winning his heat and final of a series run at Maryborough and Horsham recently.

The Union Guy four year old had his first win on Australian soil in mid April and then ran two good races against more experienced performers in his next two starts.

June 2nd saw him drawing two behind the gate at Maryborough but the good draw was negated by the fact that he ended up 3 back on the outer for much of the race.

Pacemaker Jackson Street poured on the speed as the approached the last quarter and Nakasaki Magoo pulled out from the one, one sit with Bailey Bromac even wider. Home turn arrived and on the tight bend he didn't even get a chance to balance himself before charging home from a good way back, passing the pacemaker halfway down the straight and going on to an ever-increasing 4 metre winning margin.

The time for the 2190m was 2:41.7 with a mile rate of 1:58.8.

The Final was run at Horsham just over a week later with Bailey Bromac being sent out second favourite behind the 11 win horse Petes Elect who was drawn 2 on the front line with Bailey right behind him on the second line.

With Bailey Bromac pacing well in the one out one back position, things were looking good until down the back straight when the challengers started to come and he became pocketed.

Turning for home he was full of pace but lacking a bit on room. Luck was on his side though as he was able to find a gap and came out in time to launch a fast winning run.

Second home was the Live Or Die filly Nakasaki Magoo 2 metres back with favourite Petes Elect coming late for third.

The victory took his record to 4 wins and 4 places to date from just 11 starts. He is yet to finish further back than 5th and has won over \$21,000 in stakes with a fastest time of 1:58.2.

He is out of the Transport Chip mare **Belle Fiore** who also left the Australian winners Nakamuro and Jannick before dying in 2005. Belle Fiore herself was one of only four foals (2 fillies) from the Scottish Hanover mare Gaelic Girl who also produced **Wood Chip** (p, 1:57.6 \$86,338), a full brother to Belle Fiore.
