TRACK RECORD TO HILTON BROMAC

Three year old filly **Hilton Bromac** was super impressive in running her rivals ragged in track record time at Shepparton last Sunday (Feb 14).

A very clear, hot favourite, she drew one behind the gate speeding to the lead as the car pulled away and was never headed after.

After a second last quarter of 28.7, she increased her lead as they came to the bend and although allowed to cruise the last 100m, she still was well clear as the line arrived with more than 8 metres back to the runner up **Arachniphobia** and a clear 21 metres to third placed horse **Cee Cee Sheffield**.

The overall time for the 1690m was 2:03.2 – a mile rate of 1:57.4 and a track record to boot.

The Wangaratta Vicbred Trophy was three year old **Hilton Bromac**'s second win to date and came on the heels of a good third in 1:57 flat at Tabcorp Park on February 4th. She has raced just ten times so far for seven cheques including two starts as a juvenile for a win and a second in the Loddon Valley Stud Classic.

She is the second foal of the \$100,000 winning mare **Edna Bromac** who also set a track record as a three year old filly, hers being at Maryborough where she won in 1:58.3 on debut.

Edna Bromac's first foal is the four year old mare by **Badlands Hanover**, **Elly Bromac**, who last raced in January of 2009 and from a brief 11 start career that began as a late three year old, she won 3 times and earned 9 cheques for her owners.
