BROMAC MARAVU IN 1:52.2 AT HARRINGTON

Badlands Hanover gelding **Bromac Maravu** won his fourth win of 2008 when he won at Harrington today, recording his fastest mark of the year in the process.

Drawn to leave from post three, **Bromac Maravu** was the public's elect and came away well settling into the third spot on the rails. Pushed back as others progressed, he was fifth entering the home straight but came over the top of the field to win going away.

Second home was **U Lucky Guy**, who had started from the six post but showed high speed at the start to take the lead, where he stayed until nabbed by **Bromac Maravu** in the home straight.

Third place was filled by another fast finisher in **Nights Nautical** who entered the straight just ahead of **Bromac Maravu**.

The overall time of the mile was 1:52.4 with the first half of the race representing the greatest speed – they reached the half mile pole in 54.4, the three quarters saw a time of 1:22.8 appearing on the infield clock; the last quarter took 29.6 although the winner came home in 29 flat.

Bromac Maravu has now won 12 races lifetime – 6 in both New Zealand and North America. His fastest win to date was a 1:50.4 clocking at Colonial Downs last year and his lifetime earnings are now over \$121,000.

His dam is the unraced **Live Or Die** mare **Nice Bromac** who has 4 live foals on the ground to date. **Bromac Maravu** was her first foal with the qualified 3YO filly **Neesey Bromac** (now 4) her next foal. A two year old **McArdle** filly and a yearling **Red River Hanover** colt round out her progeny to date. She did produce a colt to **McArdle** after **Neesey Bromac** but that offspring has since died.
