BAILEY BROMAC RECORDS 1:58.2 IN HIS FIRST AUSTRALIAN WIN

Union Guy four year old **Bailey Bromac** broke through for his first win on Australian soil last night when he recorded a convincing victory at Ballarat over the distance of 1710m.

Five previous Australian starts had garnered a second, 2 thirds, a fourth and a good fifth in the **Listed** Northern Region Championship so his victory was no surprise.

An overall time of 2:05.6 for the 1710m saw a mile rate of 1:58.2, the last quarter in 29.6.

Bailey Bromac won his sole New Zealand start when he defeated Flying Ermis at Invercargill last December, recording a mile rate of 2:01.6 after a last half in 57.9. Runner up Flying Ermis has won 3 races since then.

He is out of the Transport Chip mare **Belle Fiore** who also left the Australian winners Nakamuro and Jannick before dying in 2005. Belle Fiore herself was one of only four foals (2 fillies) from the Scottish Hanover mare Gaelic Girl who also produced **Wood Chip** (p, 1:57.6 \$86,338), a full brother to Belle Fiore.

Bailey Bromac has now won 2 races and almost \$12,000 from his seven starts to date.
