IMPRESSIVE SPRINT GIVES SMUDGE BROMAC THE VICTORY

Falcon Seelster colt **Smudge Bromac** was just too strong for his opponents in the www.harness.org.au 2YO Pace at Moonee Valley on Friday night (July 18th).

The two year old notched his third Australian win from just four starts to date and looked right on target for the remaining rounds of the Australasian Breeders Crown Series.

Sitting back in the rear few until the last 900m he made his move as the field left the straight and flushed out **Sandler** who was sitting in front of him. Moving down the back straight he was sitting three wide with cover and looked full of running.

Turning for home however he came a little wide as he pulled out to get clear running room and lost some ground, but the result was never in doubt. Even though he was 4 lengths from the leader at the top of the straight it was obvious that he was the one with finishing power in his legs and he passed leader **Rip N Burn** with ease.

Presidential Lane, who had entered the straight behind **Smudge Bromac** also finished well once balanced and snared the second spot on the line.

The 2100m mobile was covered in 2:39.2 with the mile rating a time of 2:02 flat, the last half in 58.1 and the final quarter in 28.7 off the front.

Smudge Bromac is now just shy of \$30,000 in his debut season and after some unlucky runs in New Zealand he has been almost faultless in Australia. Three impressive wins and a tough third in the \$100,000 Kevin Seymour Final after sitting in the suicide spot have augured well for the immediate future of his racing career.
