SIX DAYS – SEVEN WINS AND MORE TO COME

Bromac runners have saluted the judge seven times already in just the last 6 days – great news at any time but timely for a number of mares with offspring in the upcoming New Zealand Yearling Sales.

Tex Bromac started the ball rolling when he won at Gloucester Park on Friday night. He won easily over 2100m in a 1:59.3 mile rate. It was his ninth win to date and he is closing in over \$80,000. His dam *Take After Franco* is the half sister to *Tangier Franco* who has a *Bettor's Delight filly* (Lot 15) in the Christchurch Sales.

Saturday saw a trio of winners spearheaded by the super impressive win of **Gilt Bromac** at Melton on Victoria Cup Night. She finished very strongly in a mile rate of 1:57.8 to record her 21st lifetime win and take her earnings beyond \$184,000.

Just as easy in winning was **Beetee Bromac** who won at Newcastle shortly before Gilt's win. He won over the 2030m in a rate of 2:01 – his eleventh lifetime win.

Murillo Bromac was rewarded for being ultra consistent when he also won on Saturday at Burnie. This took his earnings to over \$72,000 with 11 wins to date.

Sunday saw Gilt Bromac's family back in the limelight when younger half brother **Golden Bromac** won at Bridgetown in WA, in a lifetime best of 1:56.8.

Tuesday 21st December saw just three Bromac named runners at the Manukau meeting and they came away with two wins (the other runner losing his chance at the start of the maiden trot).

Taffeta Bromac, whose dam *Trapiche* has a *Christian Cullen filly* (Lot 188) in the Christchurch Sales, won her second race in a row when she scored by half a length over 2400m on the Alexandra Park Course. She rated 2:00.4 for the 3YO's and Older Event. Taffeta Bromac is the first foal of *Trapiche*.

In the event preceding Taffeta's, 1:50.4 winning mare *On Sky* gained a timely boost to her broodmare status when **Clive Bromac** won at his second start. The three year old is the first of *On Sky's* foals. Her second foal, a *Christian Cullen filly*, is Lot 149 in the Australasian Sales in Auckland.
