DIXIE BROMAC CAPS A TRIPLE DIPPER DAY

Smart mare **Dixie Bromac** capped a grand day for Bromac families when she easily took out the penultimate race at Albion Park today (Jan 22).

The mare backed up well from last week's successful return to racing after an 8 month break. Drawing two on the second row today, she settled back early before coming home well to win by an easy 2 ½ metres.

Dixie Bromac has compiled an impressive record to date with 10 wins (and 7 placings) from just 19 starts and today's winning mile rate of 1:59.8 was her third consecutive sub 2:00 win.

Earlier on the programme **Connor Patrick** (a son of **Do You Bromac**) simply destroyed his opposition despite being 3 wide early.

He won by over 12 metres in a rate of 1:58.4 to record his 5th win for the season and 30th lifetime.

The following event was taken out by the close relation to **Abba Bromac** and **Antrim Bromac** in **Arma Fake**.

The **Fake Left** gelding had had little luck in his previous race start but made sure of his chances this time by leading from the outset.

It was his 13th career victory and took his earnings beyond the magical \$100,000 barrier.
