SLICK IS SLICK AGAIN

Four year old **Slick Bromac** made it five wins from just eight starts this season when he won his heat of the Bathurst Gold Crown Series at Bathurst yesterday.

A warm favourite in the race, **Slick Bromac** drew nine behind the gate and after being three wide for the early part of the race he settled outside the leader until they entered the last turn.

Pacemaker **Tulhurst Crusader** was going strongly as they entered the straight and gaps were starting to appear throughout the field, but the biggest gap soon appeared as **Slick Bromac** made his move from the suicide spot to a clear leading position to score a convincing and untouched win.

Tulhurst Crusader held on well for second almost 8 metres behind him whilst **Abadattitudeeagle** was just over a metre back in a brave third after racing three wide in the death for more than half of the race.

Slick Bromac covered the 2130m in 2:40.8, the mile rating in 2:01.5.

The **Falcon Seelster** gelding has now won half of his 16 lifetime starts and seven of his ten Australian starts, recording sub 2:00 victories in both his three and four year old seasons to date. A similar record is owned by his younger brother **Smudge Bromac** who has won five of his nine Australian starts to date and likewise sub 2:00 records at each age.

They are the first two foals of the **Live Or Die** mare **Sabrina Bromac** whose pedigree can be found in our **Broodmare section**.
