## HILTON BROMAC WINS 2YO DEBUT

**Rustler Hanover** filly **Hilton Bromac** was impressive in winning her debut at Warragul yesterday afternoon.

The two year old drew the pole position over the 1785 metre journey and showed gate speed to lead from the start.

Punters were mixed in their opinion as to who was the best chance between the first starters **Hilton Bromac** (1) and **Traviano** (5) and dual winner **I Look A Lot** (11) with **Western Terror** colt **Traviano** taking a slight advantage in the end.

However once **Hilton Bromac** got the front spot **Traviano** was stuck in the death and **I Look A Lot** in three wide lines, pretty much their positions for the rest of the race.

Sooled down the back **Hilton Bromac** teased **Traviano** by letting him getting his head in front as they rounded the turn, but once they straightened up she got serious and took the lead back, crossing the line more than two metres clear and without a lot of urging.

The time for the journey was 2:17 with a mile rate of 2:03.5. The last quarter was covered in 29.1.

The two year old filly is the second foal of the **Falcon Seelster** mare **Edna Bromac**, an outstanding racemare who won over \$100,000 in stakes including the Group 2 Queen of the Pacific. She raced for only 15 months during her 3 and 4 year old seasons but was good enough to win 13 races including a 5 win streak as a 3YO filly.

To date she is the dam of four live foals and from two of racing age, now has two winners.

**Edna Bromac**'s first foal is the four year old mare by **Badlands Hanover**, **Elly Bromac**, who last raced in January of this year and has won 3 races to date. She then visited **Rustler Hanover** but the resultant foal died. Returning to **Rustler Hanover** the following season, **Hilton Bromac** was the result and since then she has seen **Artsplace** twice for two live colts.
