BROMAC MARES IN 1:54 RUNS AT MENANGLE

With a number of Bromac performers in fine form in Australia lately, two mares in particular have been standouts for consistency and high speed – **Seshny** and **Vienna**.

Seshny Bromac has been in great form since arriving on Australian shores in late December with 10 starts for 6 wins and a close second.

March has seen her race three times for 2 wins and a close fought second with the highlight being a blistering 1:53.9 win at Menangle on March 12.

She drew wide that night but was out fast to get handy to the leaders in a blistering opening quarter of 26.3. Rounding the home turn she drew out to make her run and was always going to win, despite running in when clear and allowing the runner up to get close within half a head of her.

This past Friday she again drew wide at 8. Three wide in the open for the first quarter after sprinting from the gate, she then sat in the death until taking the lead in the straight and just losing by a nose on the line. A totally high game effort in a 1:56.7 mile.

Last week another Bromac mare was added to the 1:54 roll when **Vienna Bromac** proved too strong over the mile, also at Menangle.

Drawing 5 and back early, she started to make her run 400m out and was in high gear as they rounded the home bend and never looked like losing.

1:54 flat with a final quarter of 27.8, **Vienna Bromac** has also been in fine form since arriving in Australia last September with 5 wins and 3 places from just 10 starts.
