BROMAC JONES TOO STRONG FROM BARRIER 7

Race favourite **Bromac Jones** had to work hard for the first quarter from the wide draw of seven in his race at Menangle this past Friday but it wasn't enough to tip the race in favour of his opponents.

The smart four year old is still on the way up in just his second race campaign but proved too strong and too fast in the end.

Covering the mile in 1:56.7, **Bromac Jones** ran a final quarter of 27.2 to ensure he would not lose after doing the most work in the race.

It was his second win from just four starts after seven months away from the track.

His first run back saw him finish 4th in a 1:56.9 event at Albion Park on February 8th. A short break and he returned a month later with a 1:56.2 winning effort at Menangle before running 4th from barrier 5 in a 1:53.8 race the following week. This was after sitting in the death until challenging the leader at 600m where he then took the lead before the home turn, getting rundown in the last bit but still finishing close up in the final analysis.

The smart 4YO is a son of **Artsplace** and **Jillbo**. Jillbo is the dam of 5 foals of racing age for 4 qualifiers including a current 2YO. Her **Mach Three** yearling went through the ring at the recent NZ PGG Wrightson Yearling Sales and has broken in very well, already looking very comfortable in his hobbles.

Bromac Jones also has a half sister by **McArdle** in **J'Adore Bromac** – a lightly raced but very promising winner already while the **McArdle** 2YO is highly rated.

None of which should be surprising when you consider **Jillbo** herself was a sub 1:54 performer and winner of over \$300,000 lifetime.
