COSIMO BROMAC BEST AT HAROLD PARK

Cosimo Bromac capped off some recent good form when he won well at Harold Park last Friday (May 22).

Drawn 4 he was sitting outside the leader Dream Wiper with a lap to go and proved too strong for him up the home straight. Almost 2 metres further back was Deadly Handsome who also ran a strong race after being three wide without cover.

Cosimo Bromac covered the 1760m in an overall time of 2:13.4, rating 2:02 flat for the mile with sub 30 quarters over the last half.

It was his fifth start since resuming in April after a long spell. First up he finished a close fourth and since then has won, run third and a second before last week's victory.

Last season he was also very consistent winning four races and placing six times after leaving NZ shores, taking a mark of 1:58.4.

His lifetime record is currently 7 wins and 12 places for earnings over \$35,000 with a lot of opportunities to come.

The five year old is an all American bred with his dam being the 1:54 **Laag** mare **Clearly Visible** who won over \$170,018 in her North American career. Unfortunately only five foals were obtained from her before she died in September 2006 with **Cosimo Bromac** her sole winner to date, although she also produced the qualifier **Major Clive**. Her first foal was the **Falcon Seelster** mare **Clearly Invincible** whose first foal in turn is the 4YO mare **Camilla Jaccka** which opened her winning account at Winton in March of this year taking a mark of 2:02.

This is the North American family of **Artsplace** who was a world champion on the track and has obviously carried his greatness into the siring barn.
