## AND KILMORE MAKES SIX FOR HOLLYWOOD

**Hollywood Bromac** made it six on end when scoring an easy victory at Kilmore last night.

The **Red River Hanover** gelding drew five behind the gate and was away well, but **Bekam Boy** and **Little Vance Lot** both tried to hold the lead before finally handing up to him. It had taken him 600m to get to the front so once he got there driver Hackett immediately slowed the field down to give him a breather.

Back in the field public elect and last seasons Group One winning **Villagem** was having an easy time of it, whilst third favourite **Little Vance Lot** was coasting along on **Hollywood Bromac**'s back, just waiting for the passing lane.

Approaching the back straight **Hollywood Bromac** upped the tempo enough to cover the second last quarter in 28.4 ... noticeably up on the previous quarter of 33.7. It spread the field at a vital time and caught a few napping.

The public might have only had him as the second favourite despite his picket line of victories, but rounding the home turn it was apparent that he didn't agree with them. **Villagem** had come up to be handy, but **Hollywood Bromac** simply turned on a little bit of his "star" sprint and came clear without much asking from Hackett to make it clear all the way down the straight that he was in control.

It was an easy, almost three metre victory from a horse that had actually done the most work in the race. The time might not have been spectacular – 2:44.2 for the 2180 metres, a mile rate of 2:01.2 – but he had done what he was asked to do .. go out and win .. now six straight.

It was **Hollywood Bromac**'s 11th win from just 16 lifetime starts and his 8th win from 11 starts this season. He has now earned over \$64,000 to date and has a fastest time of 1:57.5.

Out of the **Falcon Seelster** mare **Happy Bromac**, he is the first foal of his dam and her second, a current two year old in **Hampton Bromac** has already qualified.
