BACK TO BACK FOR CAPTAIN BROMAC

Well bred 5YO **Captain Bromac** made it back to back wins at Tabcorp Park when he won the sixth event on their programme last Friday night (Sept 25).

The **Falcon Seelster** gelding had been impressive winning there the previous week and on the strength of that went out as the \$2.30 public elect.

After drawing 4 at barrier it looked like it would not be too hard for him, but he wasn't in the mood to make things easy and galloped away as the starter let them go. Sitting 3 wide early he made a run for the front before the half way point was reached and once in the lead he settled down to show why the public had shown so much support for him.

Although not left alone in front he had the field at his mercy from well before they turned for home and he strolled up the straight pretty much untouched, with only trailer **Unicycle** getting anywhere near him. And that was only because he maintained a solid even clip rather than being driven all out as his opponents were. His winning margin was almost 4 metres, the largest pacing win of the night.

The 2240m stand was covered in a time of 2:49.1 with the mile rating a 2:01.5 and the last half in 58.2.

It was **Captain Bromac**'s sixth start since being exported from NZ six weeks ago. He has now had 2 wins, 3 places and a fifth for earnings of over \$15,000 in Australia to date and combined with his 5 NZ wins, he is sitting in the shadows of \$50,000 in lifetime winnings.

He is one of 5 2:00 performers of his dam, the all American bred Classic Blue Jeans and a full brother to NZ's former fastest pacer ever **Attorney General (p, 1:48.8US \$323,098)** and a half brother to smart West Australian pacer **Crown Bromac (p3, 1:57.7)**.
