LATE SPRINT NABS WIN FOR CAPTAIN BROMAC

A slushy track and persistent rain were not enough to stop **Captain Bromac** gaining his second win from just 5 starts to date when he won the final race at Rangiora Raceway this afternoon.

The impressive looking **Falcon Seelster** 3YO has not had the best of luck in his short career and after doing some work before being placed in the one out one back position, he was a bolt hole turning home for home and looking for luck. Fortunately for him however, the death seat horse ran a little wide just after they straightened and he was able to come through with a well timed sprint to nab the favourite Cadence just short of the post and win going away by an ever increasing quarter of a length.

Captain Bromac is a full brother to NZ's former fastest pacer ever **Attorney General** (p, 1:48.8US \$323,098) and a half brother to this seasons highly promising West Australian 2YO **Crown Bromac** (p2, 1:59.6).

One of two **Falcon Seelster** sired winners on a rainy day, the other was a 3YO filly named **To Ri Dette**. This promising filly was having only her third start after finishing third in both her prior start, but took home the major end of the stake this time.

To Ri Dette is out of the **Soky's Atom** mare **Big Bopper** who is a half sister to another **Bromac Lodge** mare in **Nice Bromac**. A **Live Or Die** mare, **Nice Bromac**'s first foal **Bromac Maravu** has been carrying on the family tradition of high speed with a fastest mile rate to date of **1:50.4** in the US after winning in 1:56.5 in New Zealand as a three year old.
