PALAZZO BROMAC IN WINNING AUSTRALIAN DEBUT

Falcon Seelster gelding **Palazzo Bromac** opened his Australian career with an easy win at Bendigo this afternoon.

Sitting in the trail after drawing the 2 gate, his position looked a bit precarious 400m out when the leader seemed to be struggling, but once he saw daylight in the home straight **Palazzo Bromac** came fast along the rails to win by an increasing margin.

It was only his third lifetime start and first on Australian soil and although he showed greenness in the home straight, he showed the acceleration of a pacer likely to win more in the near future.

The 2150 metres was covered in 2:45.1 with the last quarter in 28.5.

Palazzo Bromac is the first foal of former **Southland 3YO Filly of the Year Pam Bromac** who took a mark of 1:57.2 whilst numbering heats of the Group 1 Nevele R three year old fillies series and Southland Oaks amongst her wins. She also gained numerous minor placings in those series and finished a good 4th in the **\$100,000 Group 1 Nevele R 3YO Fillies Final** and a photo-ed finish 5th in the **Group 1 NZ Oaks** where second through fifth places were a "bob of the head" distance apart.

Pam Bromac is a half sister to the 1:54 performer **Drew Bromac** who has won over a quarter of a million dollars to date.
